Meanwhile more children with different needs came and we started building our centre.

Today we have 20 children living here, 6 youngsters whom we keep in boarding schools paying for their education, and 9 handicapped children living with their parents but getting help with medical expenses and transport from us.

Our children go to school every day. Some are living in boarding- secondary schools and even training centers and university. Those who are too handicapped to attend a regular school are taught at Tumaini

The funding is mainly coming from schools in Klepp - Norway, private people and organizations like lions clubs and businesses.

Some have organized monthly payment to our account

The work with the children`s Home will expand accordingly to the funds we have. If you want to help us educating more children or letting us expand our handicap centre we will be ever so grateful.
